Dear Coaches & Local Town Coordinators;

We are thrilled to share with you that the **31st Annual Old Mill Invitational** will be held on October 18th - 19th, 2025 on the north side of the Peotone High School.

We encourage you to consider entering a team to our 31st annual tournament this year. Teams will need to be registered on-line no later than Sunday, September 21st at www.oldmillinvitational.com. All registration documents & a single check made payable to OMSA in the amount of \$450 or in cash will need to be delivered to Dave Wehrmann at Peotone American Legion at, 109 E. North Street, Peotone, IL 60468 on **Sunday, September 21st between 12:00 PM to 4:00 PM**. If you can't make that timeframe, please contact Dave at (708)-774-8479 to deliver the registration materials prior to Sept. 21st. If all registration materials are in order and received by this date, the team's coach will receive a \$50 "on-time" refund at game day check-in on Oct. 18th. Payments delivered after Sept. 21st will need to be cash or a cashier check only, no personal checks accepted.

The age groups participating will be all Boys and/or Co-ed (any combination) U8, U10, U12 & U14 and all Girls U8, U10, U12 & U14 using a cutoff of August 1. All U8 & U10 teams will play 8 on the field and a maximum roster size of 15. U12 teams will play 8 on the field with a maximum roster of 18. U14 Boys/Coed teams will play 11 on the field with a maximum roster of 18. U14 Girls will play 7 on the field with a maximum roster of 18. You may have up to a total of three coaches and IHSA rules will be followed. Players are limited to the school district of the town being represented or may play for the town of the recreational league they played in this fall season. Each team has the option of utilizing a limited number of club/traveling players not to exceed 3 for, U8 & U10 or 4 for U12 & U14. A club/traveling player is defined as being active on a club or traveling team anytime August 1 – October 18, 2025. Active means either playing or being rostered with a player card during the noted time period. The player's status per this definition, either non-club or club, will need to be properly indicated by their parents on the waiver form and confirmed by their parents' signature. The coach is still responsible to ensure that the proper number of club/traveling players is not exceeded. A team will forfeit any games played in violation of this rule by a score of 3 to 0, pursuant to OMSA Board review. All age groups will be awarded trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places and no awards or ribbons for any place below 3rd.

There will be no overnight parking, campers, or travel trailers allowed. There will be a concession stand available both days operated by OMSA and your patronage will be greatly appreciated. If you have any questions, you may call me at 773-988-4369.
